Around the World



How our learning will link to Year 1 children's lives, interests and experiences

As we look towards our final term in Year 1 we look forward to learning about the culture and ways of life in different countries such as Brazil. We will explore the history of the seaside looking at how it has changed over time. We look forward to a Samba Drumming workshop and a Seaside day! We will explore musical instruments and create our own instrument during Design and Technology. We will learn about being a good team player when we practise for our Sports Day! By the end of the summer term we will begin to transition to Year 2 and explore our new classrooms and meet our new teachers! This is an exciting event but also a time to consider our feelings to change.

Learning in the Core subjects

- In English we will be consolidating what we know makes a good sentence for our EPOW (capital letters, finger spaces and end punctuation) and demonstrate use of the conjunction 'and' to join two sentences. This term we are going to create a Caribbean Counting Rhyme and create our own innovated story based on 'The Mixed-up Chameleon' by Eric Carle.
- In Maths we will be learning to tell the time, learn about fractions and numbers up to 100.
- In Science we will explore and name common animals and describe and compare the structure of these.

- We will learn to identify and make times for o'clock and half past.

Fractions

- To find half and a quarter using shapes and numbers. Even in more complex problems such as these!
