What an interesting year we all had! We have missed seeing you all on a regular basis and look forward to a time when things begin to return to normal.

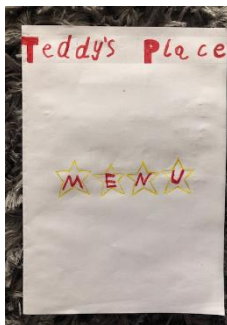

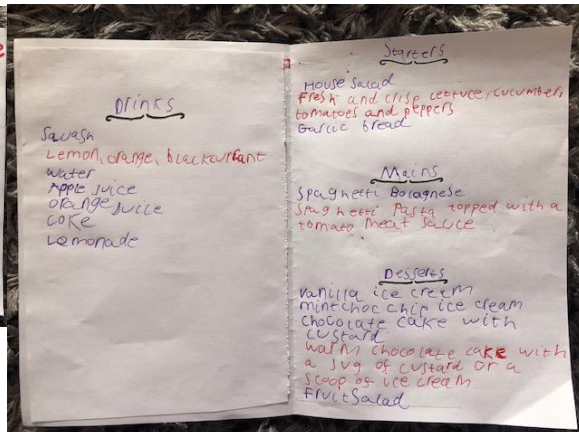

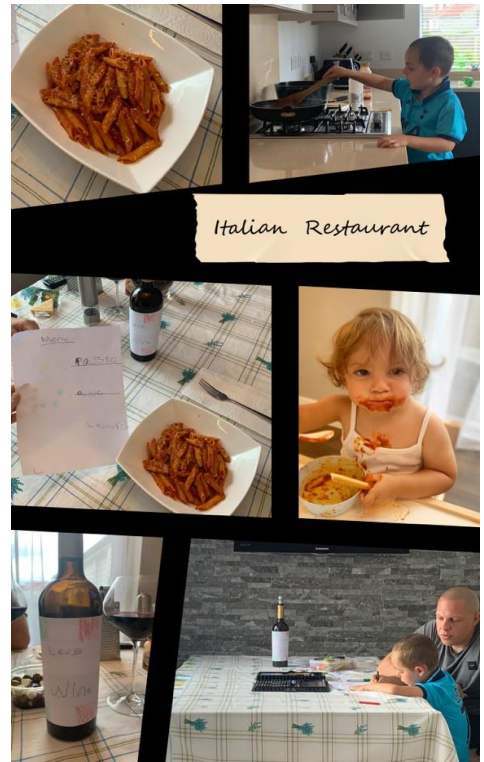
