



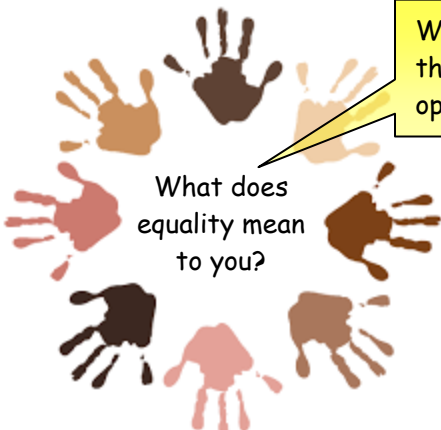

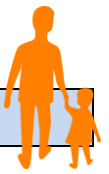

Sia did a long piece of writing for homework that told us all about her new guinea-pigs and how she planned for them coming.



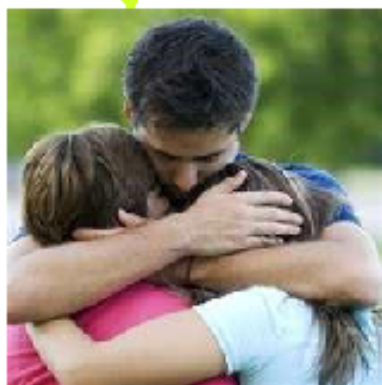
