When emailing or leaving answerphone messages please include your child's name and class to make it easier and quicker to deal with your message or query.

Parents in Reception, Year 1 and 2 can contact class teachers on class email addresses but this should not be used for messages that are urgent or about pick up arrangements or absences. Class teachers will aim to check these emails weekly in term time but will not be expected to check these emails during weekends and school holidays.

Forest school reminder

Your child must come dressed for forest school on the day their session is due to take place. Forest school sessions take place in all weathers including snow, rain and heat so please always assume your child's session will take place.

- Legs must be covered (eg full length leggings or joggers)
- A long-sleeved top (jumper, sweatshirt or long-sleeved T-shirt in warmer weather)
- A warm waterproof coat
- Hat and gloves (In colder weather)
- Wellies in a named plastic bag together with a spare change of clothing in case your child gets wet or muddy

Please ensure your child's wellies are cleaned after each forest school session.

We had some children who did not come to school with the correct kit this week which delayed the the start of the sessions, please remember when you child is due to attend Forest School this half term.


