Monday 6th November: morning session from 9—12 o'clock Monday 6th November: afternoon session from 1—3 o'clock



Year 1 Learning

For the end of their Art unit of "Woven Wonders" in October the Year 1 Children collaborated in groups to make their own piece of Fibre Art.

Inspired by the work of Cecila Vicuna, over the previous weeks the children had learnt to weave, knot, plait and wrap. They then included all of these skills in a final product where they used a

box loom and attached their various pieces of fibre art to create a finished product. Ava said she enjoyed "weaving. You go in and out and in and out." Raiyah said she liked "plaiting" and explained to plait you need to put the string "in the middle, out the middle, in the middle, out the middle".
