from the Active and Safer Travel Team at Hertfordshire County Council

This is notification that as from next Monday, 18th October 2021, the School Crossing Patrol in Cadmore Lane will be wearing a body camera.

The use of body worn cameras by School Crossing Patrols is being trialled across the county to ensure drivers comply with stop requests as well as reducing any possible intimidation.

The closing date for applications for starting nursery in September 2022 will be midday on Wednesday 9th March 2022.
