As part of our Active Travel policy we are supporting Walk to School Week again this year.

Walking to school makes children feel healthier and happier, while reducing congestion and pollution outside the school gates. So why not swap the car journey to a walk? If you live a distance away, set off a little earlier, park up safely and walk the last 5 minutes to school.

Reminder about Packed Lunches

- One sandwich or other similar carbohydrate alternative
- 1/3 pieces of vegetable or small fruit eg Strawberries/cucumber or 1 piece of larger fruit
- A small treat such as a biscuit
- No additional drinks, they will use their class water bottle
- Please only include items in packaging that the children can undo themselves
