White Rose Maths App

White Rose Maths is the scheme we use to teach maths in our school.

White Rose Maths have just published a new, FREE mobile app that offers children engaging and easily accessible practise in basic number.

The first version of the app focuses on adding and subtracting, including subitising. There's no specific route or starting point. Having chosen a topic, each user answers a series of randomly generated questions (a different set of questions every time means they learn the concept, not the sequence of answers). When the one minute's up, the questions are automatically marked and presented on a breakdown screen, giving instant feedback on how they've done.

If they are struggling with a questions, a "hint" button reformats the questions as a familiar manipulative display that mirrors the approach used in school.

The free mobile app is available for Apple/iOS, Android and Kindle.
