Forest School and PE timetable

Forest School:

Forest school sessions for next half term will be for children in **Year 1** and **Year 2** children:

Your child must come dressed for forest school on the day their session is due to take place. Forest school sessions take place in all weathers including snow, rain and heat so please always assume your child's session will take place.

You can really help prepare your child for a Forest School day by:

- Having the correct clothing: a warm jacket, wellie boots and two pairs of socks (gloves and hats in colder weather)
- Bringing in a spare set of clothes just in case your child gets wet and needs to change.
- Even better, if you have it, waterproof clothing: jacket, an over-suit or over trousers, children would be snug, dry and comfortable for their session. Here is a link for a cost effective waterproof set: Amazon Link for waterproof clothing
- Don't forget to name label all clothing so any lost items can get back to you!

Please ensure your child's wellies are cleaned after each forest school session. We have attached a Be Free Forest School guide to help you ensure your child has the correct clothing for their sessions.

PE:

Children should come to school dressed in their PE uniform on their allocated PE days. PE will take place whenever the weather allows. Please dress your child in the following for their PE lesson:

- Black/navy shorts, leggings or joggers
- White or light blue T-shirt
- School jumper/cardigan
- Trainers

SchoolGrid lunch ordering

Please can we remind parents of the following information regarding our SchoolGrid lunch ordering system:

- Lunch orders need to be placed or cancelled before 8:30am on the day
- If your child is absent from school, please remember to cancel their meal order
- If no lunch order is received before 8:30am, a Jacket Potato will be provided for your child





If you need any support with the SchoolGrid system or have been unable to access your account please contact the School Office.

Cancelling Lunches:

If your child is absent or you provide a home packed lunch you must cancel their lunch order by 8:30am.

If you don't do this the school will still be charged for the lunch and will pass this charge on to you. Parents who do not cancel their child's meal if their child is absent from school will be charged for the meal at the current rate of £2.58
