
Reindeer Run-Isabel Hospice

This week we received our fundraising certificate for the Brookland Federation Reindeer run that took place in December. We are delighted that we raised an amazing £1610 for the Isabel Hospice! The Isabel Hospice has asked us to extend their heartfelt thanks to everyone at the Brookland Federation for supporting them. Together, the campaign has raised an incredible total of £17,794.46 and the amount is still growing! This amount is enough to cover the costs of a room in our In-Patient Unit for over three weeks, making a profound difference to the care the hospice can provide.



School Gates

Our school governors have now reviewed the situation regarding the closing of the main gates during the school day. The outcome of the review is that during the Easter holidays we will be having some work completed on the gates which will make them electronic going forward. This will mean that during the school day the gates will be closing and will only be left open at drop off and pick times, at other times both vehicle and pedestrian access on to the school site will be controlled by an intercom
