The children in reception enjoyed a visit from Allstars Circus this week, the hall was filled with laughter as the children watched a circus performance and then got to try performing their own circus skills. The children learnt how to catch scarves, spin plates, balance peacock feathers on their hands, walk on stilts, use pedal-gos, and had fun rolling and catching flower twirlers and many more circus skills.

We are pleased to say we have many budding circus artists in reception! well done to all the children who took part, we are very proud of your resilience and perseverance.

#### Forest School Adventures

We've had typical Wintery weather on our return to Brookland Infant's own Forest School area, and the children have loved every minute of their sessions!



Year 1 and nursery have both been exploring birds, learning their different birdsong, leaving out bird feeders and learning to recognise their different colours. We have a very friendly robin who sings to the children, we are so curious about him!

Jude typically leads the children in a game and then some learning about the natural world, before the children take part in an activity so they can explore this learning hands-on. After this, children may choose from activities in our Forest School area which have included: making bird feeders, digging holes to plant bulbs, making delicious 'soup' in the mud kitchen, swinging on the tree swing and picking up litter with the litter pickers.



Though it has been very cold, children have kept themselves warm by taking part in walking stories or scavenger hunts, singing our Ash Tree song whilst stomping up and down the hill and drinking warm blackcurrant squash - a special winter treat available for every child during a Forest School session. The weather is taken into consideration for each daily plan and the adults watch the children carefully to know when it's time to head back to class and warm up. The children have shown lots of wonder about the crunchy grass and frosty leaves, they were thrilled to smash ice and drink warm squash too. When it was very cold, we shortened sessions to around an hour - this experience of feeling cold, possibly uncomfortable too, is not harmful, but builds resilience, we can't always wait for sunshine, it's about learning to dance in the rain, write our name in the frost and feel the wind in our hair. It's all part of the fun of a Forest School session, being outdoors in all weather, (apart from electrical storms and high wind!)
