Admissions

The Primary Admissions application system will close on Monday 15th January 2024. Please ensure you have applied online via the link below:

Parents of Year 2 children should apply for a place at the Junior School and parents of nursery children should apply for a place in a reception class.

Nursery AppliCations-2024/25

Applications are still being accepted for children born between 1st September 2020 and 31st August 2021 to start with us in September 2024. We now accept applications for nursery places anytime during the academic year after a child's second birthday. The closing date for applications for starting nursery in September 2024 will be midday on Wednesday 6th March 2024.

School Meal Booking System

Please remember to order your child's meals in advance.

- Lunch orders need to be placed or cancelled before 8:45am on the day
- If your child is absent please remember to cancel their meal
- If no lunch order is received, the Jacket Potato or Pasta option will be provided for your child
- You can place meal orders up to 10 weeks in advance

If you need any support with the SchoolGrid system please contact the School Office.

Cancelling Lunches: If your child is absent from school or you provide a home packed lunch you must cancel their lunch order by 8:45am.

If you don't do this the school will be charged for the lunch and will pass this charge on to you. Parents who do not cancel their child's meal if their child is absent from school will be charged for the meal at the current rate of $\pounds 2.53$.

Home Prepared Packed Lunches

Please use the following guidelines when preparing your child's packed lunch:

- a) NO nuts or nut based foods such as Nutella or some cereal bars.
- b) One sandwich or other similar carbohydrate alternative
- c) 1/3 pieces of vegetable or small fruit eg Strawberries/cucumber or 1 piece of larger fruit
- d) A small treat such as a biscuit
- e) No additional drinks, they will use their class water bottle
- f) Please only include items in packaging that the children can undo themselves
