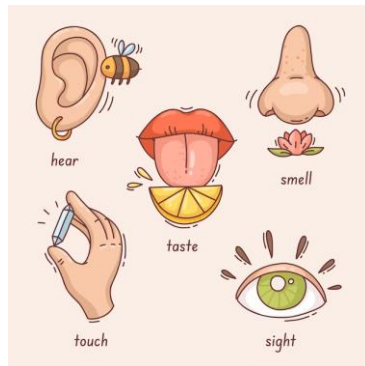

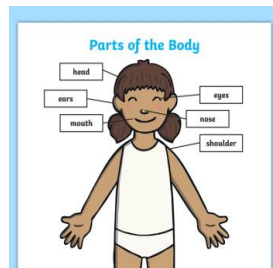


Science - Seasons

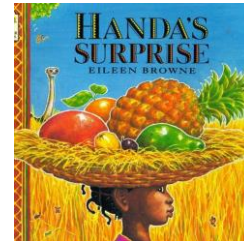
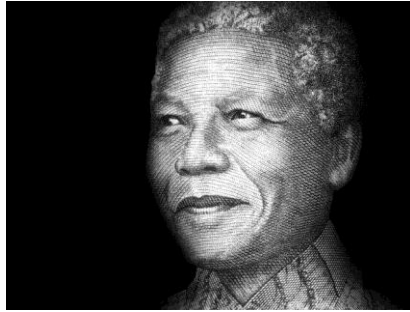
