


The Ugly Five

How our learning will link to Year 1 children's lives, interests and experiences

The children are gaining confidence in their learning all the time and are enjoying making new discoveries. They have shown they can be like Captain Perseverance, Collaboration Kid and Captain Concentration (Building Learning Powers characters) in their learning. This term we will continue to learn about the world around us by learning about the UK and will continue our learning about Africa and then Antarctica. We will explore different faiths and show respect for different beliefs.

Learning in the Core subjects

- In English we will begin to use our rainbow writing (colouring pencil for the capital and end punctuation. We will remember to write Super Sentences with capitals, fingers spaces and end punctuation (?!). We will think of and use describing words (adjectives) to enhance our writing. We will use time words (first, then, next, after that, later on, finally) to recount experiences and events.
- In Maths we will be adding and subtracting and begin to learn these as number facts to recall.
- In Geography we will begin to learn about hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.
- In Science we will learn about groups of animals (mammals, reptiles, amphibians, fish, birds).
