

Spring Term 2 - Year 2 The Tin Forest

Over the next half term, our learning will be centred around The Tin Forest written by Helen Ward. This story is about an old man who dreams of living in a wild forest bursting with life! We will use our imaginative thinking to develop our language whilst writing descriptively about a setting. We will also use this story to look deeper into the character and answer questions about the story.



<u>Handwriting</u>



We are continuing to practise the correct formation of letters, ensuring they are sitting on the line with clear distinction between ascenders and descenders.

Learning in the Core subjects

- During our English learning, we will be focussing on looking deeper into the character and the setting whilst using appropriate adjectives and words that end in -ly -ness & -ful. We will also work on our comprehension skills by learning to answer questions in detail, about a story. The Tin Forest will also link to our Science learning of Plants. We will be looking at a variety of non-fiction texts in great detail!
- In Maths, we will be looking at measurement, money, multiplication (x2, x5, x10) and division.

Maths Fluency

- Recalling facts for mulitplication and division for 2,5 & 10 times tables.
- Working out 1-step word problems.
- Answer number sentences for addition and subtraction within 50 & 100.

Phonics

We will continue to focus on practising Year 2 suffix words including words that end in -ly, -ness & -ful. We will also look at apostrophes in words.

Learning our Year 2 common exception words will also be repeated weekly!
